spacing 1.0. All paragraphs after the first one are intended 0.5. (Century Gothic, 11 pt)

Main chapter (Century Gothic, Bold, 16pt)

Subchapter (Century Gothic, Bold, 14pt)

Before the next chapter and subchapter put one blank row (hit enter once). Also, before and after figures and tables should be a blank row. (Century Gothic, 11 pt)

Avoid using footnotes. References should be written in the text using Harvard referencing style (Kish, 1965, Casady, Lepkowski, 1993) (Century Gothic, 11 pt). The examples for the References list are provided at the end of this Template. Authors should also provide a short biography. The length of biography is limited to 200 words.

Figures should be put in the text and submitted as separate documents in jpg, jpeg or tif format. Figures should have minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Every figure should have an individual title. (Century Gothic, 11 pt)

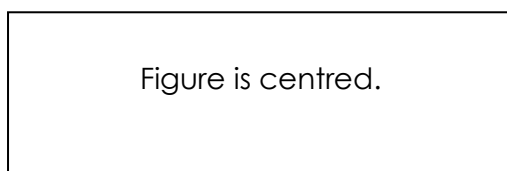


Figure 1 Figure title (Centred, Century Gothic, 11 pt)

At the end of the paper a reference list in alphabetical order should be supplied. Use Harvard style for reference. References should be numbered. References are written using font Century Gothic, 10 pt. The examples of references are provided at the end of this Template. (Century Gothic, 11 pt)
