

Statistical modelling is essential for analysing various aspects of economic policy. Economic policy analysis has evolved considerably over decades with the development of statistical modelling. There are often public debates regarding the adequate responses of economic policy makers to economic fluctuations. Sound statistical modelling should provide the basis for appropriate decision-making at macro and micro level, and thus the issue of statistical modelling gains in importance. This special issue is focused on papers that cover statistical research methods and models for economic policy making and their implication on the overall economy and welfare, with the emphasis on econometric modelling, panel data analysis and/or multivariate analysis.

Possible themes include, but are not limited to:

- The statistical analysis of economic policy efficiency in modern economies
- The econometric analysis of economic policy impacts on welfare
- Comparative multivariate research of economic development and inequality
- The quantitative evaluation of various economic policy scenarios
- The quantitative assessment of the impact of government spending
- The statistical modelling for developing adequate monetary and fiscal policy
- The econometric analysis of the coordination of monetary and fiscal policies
- The statistical modelling of the role of monetary and fiscal policy in the stabilisation of the economic cycles
